In Observance of our founding, we invite you to participate in an upcoming mission trip to Haiti. Select the trip that best fits your needs:

- **Feb. 5-10th.** In collaboration with our distribution partner, *Foundation for Peace*, you will distribute Mobility Carts to those in need in the Port-au-Prince area. Cost of this extraordinary experience is \$790 (plus the cost of airfare to/from Port-au-Prince). The price includes transportation (starting at Port-au-Prince), food, lodging, security, staffing, translation services and the distribution of Mobility Carts.
- **Feb 14-21st.** In concert with distribution partner, *Many Hands for Haiti*, you will help distribute Mobility Carts to those in need throughout the Pignon, Haiti area. Cost of this experience is \$1,395 (plus the price of your airfare to/from the Ft. Pierce, FL area: typically West Palm Beach airport). Price includes airfare aboard Missionary Flights International from Ft. Pierce, FL to Pignon, Haiti along with food, lodging, translators, security and ground transportation.

Those participating in either of these two Mobility Missions will stay on campuses that are professionally managed by the staff of Foundation for Peace (FFP) or Many Hands for Haiti (MH4H). Schedules are customized to focus heavily on the distribution of Mobility Carts. Accommodations are pleasant with electricity, clean water, indoor plumbing, bunk beds and security.

Mobility Worldwide has years of experience partnering with FFP and MH4H, two professionally run non-governmental organizations who have helped so many.

These trips are well organized and expertly managed. They're ideal for those who enjoy traveling with confidence knowing that their creature comforts are respected and their safety is of paramount importance to those in charge. Foundation for Peace Trip - Feb 5-10th:

- \$790 per person includes transportation starting at the Port-au-Prince airport, food, lodging, security, staffing, translation and costs associated with distributing Mobility Carts through local partners.
- Airfare to/from Port-au-Prince booked separately with additional cost.
- Arrivals into Port-au-Prince will be coordinated within a 2-hour window the morning of Tuesday, Feb. 5th with NO ARRIVALS to take place after 4PM.
- In addition to introductions, arrival day will include a Creole language lesson.
- Wed-Fri will include multiple Mobility Cart distributions in the Port-au-Prince area.
- Saturday includes a visit to the Men nan Men Language class where participants will converse with Haitians interested in practicing their English in a non-stressful environment and a trip to the Musée du Panthéon National Haïtien museum.
- Sunday will include Church services in Kwa Kok before departure from the Port-au-Prince airport back to the United States.
- A valid passport is required. A visa is not required. However, a \$10 entrance fee will be charged once travelers arrive at the Port-au-Prince airport.

Many Hands 4 Haiti Trip - Feb 14-21st:

- \$1,395 per person includes transportation from West Palm Beach airport to the Holiday Inn, Ft. Pierce. Transportation will then be provided from the hotel to Treasure Coast International Airport where you will board a Missionary Flights International (MFI) aircraft bound for Pignon, Haiti. Cost includes the MFI flight, ground transportation in Haiti, food, lodging, security, staffing, translation and costs associated with distributing Mobility Carts through local partners. Upon return, transportation will again be provided to West Palm Beach airport.
- Airfare to/from West Palm Beach, FL booked separately with additional cost.
- Arrivals into West Palm Beach, FL must be coordinated so that travelers are available to board an early morning flight bound for Haiti on February 14th.
- Arrival day will include introductions as well as a tour of the MH4H facility and a review of the activity schedule including cart distribution and projects such as simple construction including the installation of concrete floors and painting.
- A day will be set aside for travelers to tour The Citadelle and San Souci Palace, a large mountaintop fortress built in the early 1800s in northern Haiti. Participants will travel through beautiful remote areas and local villages with a stop in Don Don for breakfast.
- A covenant agreement must be agreed upon prior to participating in this trip.
- A valid passport is required to enter Haiti. A visa is not required.
