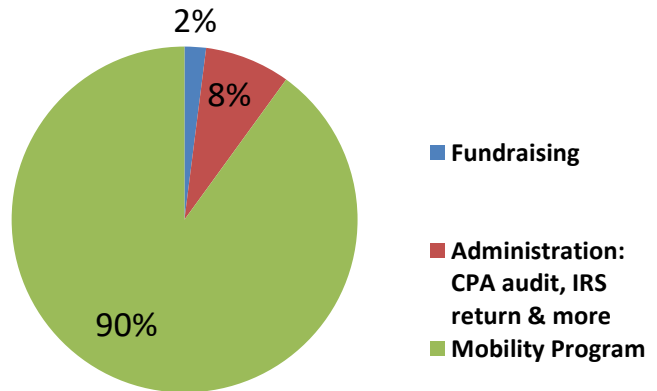
2019 Annual Report

Mobility Worldwide MO - Columbia's mission is to provide appropriate mobility for all of God's children in need. We seek to provide mobility first for those in greatest need and with the least resources in poor or underdeveloped countries.

A tax-exempt 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization supported by those who believe in its mission of mobility in the form of contributions from individuals, churches/clubs, and businesses (cash, raw materials to produce cart parts, and discounted or free cart parts).

Total revenue for FY 2019 was \$659,191.

Total expense for FY 2019 was \$737,642. Program expense was \$664,186 or 90% (shop space/construction and equipment, shipping, and reporting materials to tell the story). Management and general was \$59,407 or 8%. Fundraising expense was \$14,049 or 2%.
