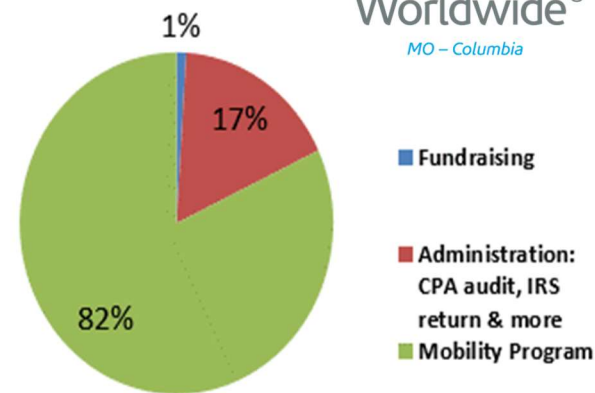
Total revenue for FY 2020 was \$1,644,126 (with designated construction gifts).

Total expense for FY 2020 was \$577,877.

Program expense was \$470,706 or 82% (equipment to set up newly constructed shop & first ever welding space inhouse, shipping, and reporting materials to tell the story).

Management and general was \$101,453 or 17% (includes one-time items to set up new office space in the completely paid for new building).

Fundraising expense was \$5,718 or 1%.
