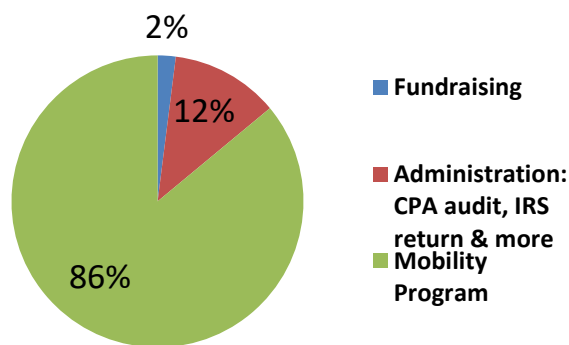
Total revenue for FY 2021 was \$731,361.

Total expense for FY 2021 was \$729,397.

Program expense was \$623,112 or 86%

(cart parts/materials, shipping, and reporting materials to tell the story).

Management and general was \$90,148 or 12%. Fundraising expense was \$16,137 or 2%.
