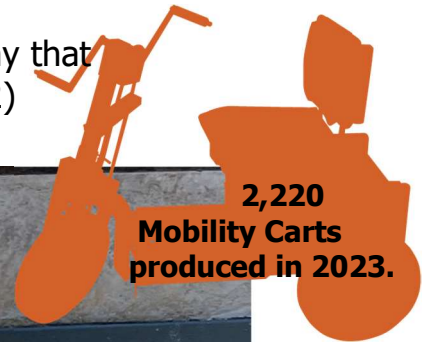


2023 Annual Report

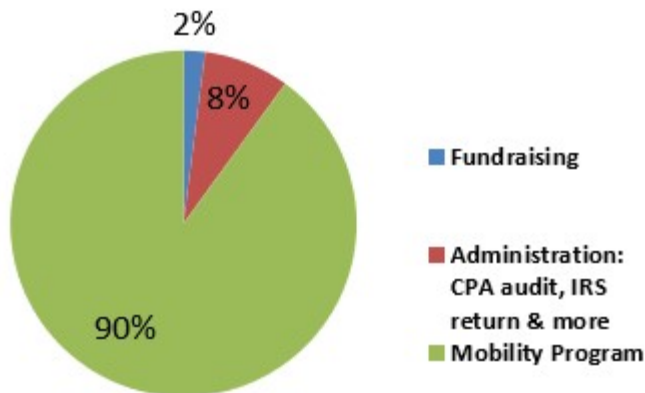

Total expense for FY 2023 was \$1,123,463.

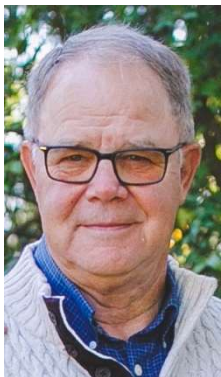
Program expense was \$1,010,264 or 90%
