


## 2024 Annual Report

- 1,336 Large Crank Carts, 460 Small Crank Carts, 274 Pull Carts, and 300 Mini-Marts produced.
- 24 shipments went to 7 countries & to 5 NGOs that ship worldwide.
- 17,352 hours by over 200 volunteers are valued at \$581,118.
- 1,209 supporters – THANK YOU.






**Cover story continued from page 1:** There are many reasons amputations occur: venomous snake bite, landmine explosions, diabetes, cancer surgery, farming equipment accident, earthquakes, vehicle accidents (motorcycle, train, car), and more.

**2024 Annual Report** A tax-exempt 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization supported by those who believe in its mission of mobility in the form of contributions from individuals, churches/clubs, and businesses (cash, raw materials to produce cart parts, and discounted or free cart parts). We want you to be confident the finances dedicated to providing Mobility Carts are used wisely. **Total revenue** for FY2024 was \$1,426,601. **Total expense** for FY2024 was \$1,028,090. Program expense was \$ 899,895 or 88% (cart parts/materials, shipping, and reporting materials to share the story). Management and general was \$98,094 or 9%. Fundraising expense was \$30,101 or 3%.
